



Getting There:

By Air:

Qantas and Virgin Australia offer daily flights to the Gold Coast. The Gold Coast Airport https://www.goldcoastairport.com.au/ is 6km south of Currumbin and 27kms south of Surfers Paradise.

By Coach:

Grey hound Australia run services twice daily from Sydney to the Gold Coast for approximately \$85.00 - \$190.00. The journey takes 16 hours.

Self-Drive:

Self-drive is fun option for mates and families travelling in big groups. The drive north from NSW is scenic with lots of hot surf spots along the way. Check out for road trip inspiration...

Board Transport:

Surfing QLD recommends all states coordinate the transportation of boards prior to the competition commencing.

Possible Competition Venues:

Currumbin will be the main competition venue however the Southern Gold Coast offers a huge variety of world class waves from beach breaks to pumping point breaks. Having these options available will make for an epic event in various conditions.

Conditions:

Queensland's Gold Coast has a sub-tropical climate with around 300 days of sunshine per year. In spring time sunny days are followed by mild tropical evenings and average temperatures range from $16.9 - 25.4^{\circ}\text{C}$

Water Temps:

Minimum water temperature of 22.7 °C and maximum of 25.6 °C
